I did this as recently as a couple of hours before the update.

I tried deleting / re-pairing with the phone. No love. Bluetooth setup assistant doesn't even see the phone. (And I did make sure the phone was discoverable!)

On my wife's 12" powerbook I got a kernel panic after installing the update. The second reboot sat for 15 minutes or so at the grey Apple screen (though the progress icon was spinning). I rebooted it again and it was fine from then on.

I haven't tried bluetooth on the powerbook yet.

Here's hoping Apple makes better soon! Thankfully I haven't updated my iMac yet, since that's now my only way to talk to the phone. And considering that one uses a bluetooth keyboard and mouse, I'm pretty afraid to update it.

Upgraded 4 machines so far with no occurrence of a black box around the cursor. All upgrades applied via Software Update to machines that were on fully up-to-date 10.4.7 installations.

1. iBook G3 600
2. Core Solo Mac mini
3. 2x1.8GHz G5
4. 2x1GHz MDD G4

I'll hit a G3/600 iMac and a 1GHz eMac in the next few days (although that last one's currently on 10.4.5).

The only issue I had was that the background app supporting my PowerMate (on the G5) crashed on the first launch after the install. Cause is unconfirmed: There's been no recurrence and it didn't happen right away.
